Talk to someone!

Are you feeling low, depressed, and anxious or just generally need to talk to someone?



We have a service offered to our patients on a Friday afternoon with a member of staff from MIND. MIND is a mental health charity who provides advice and support to empower anyone experiencing a mental health problem.

Don't bottle up your feelings book in with reception today and speak your MIND.

FREE NHS HEALTH CHECK

The NHS Health Check is a free check-up of your overall health. It can tell you whether



you're at higher risk of getting certain health problems, such as:

- Heart disease
- Diabetes
- Kidney disease
- Stroke

You should have a health check every 5 years if you're aged 40 to 74 and you have not had a stroke, or you do not have heart disease, diabetes or kidney disease. An NHS Health Check takes about 20-30 minutes.

The health professional – often a nurse or healthcare assistant – will ask you some simple questions about your lifestyle and family history, measure your height and weight, and take your blood pressure and do a blood test – often using a small finger prick test.

If you're not sure if you're eligible for an NHS Health Check and would like one, or if you are eligible but haven't had an NHS Health Check in the last 5 years, ask your surgery for an appointment now.

BREAST SCREENING

Please do not ignore your breast screening invitations!

1 in 8 women in the UK are diagnosed with breast cancer during their lifetime. If it's detected early, treatment is more successful and there's a good chance of recovery

Please bear in mind all screenings are completed by **FEMALE** health practitioners. If you haven't had yours within the first 3 years after turning 50 book in **NOW!**
