

#### **COVID SPRING BOOSTERS**

NHS England have confirmed that there will be a spring COVID booster for the following cohorts:

- Adults aged 75 years and over
- Residents in a care home for older adults
- Individuals aged 5 years and over who are immunosuppressed as defined in the green book

This includes those who turn 75 years old by 30th June 2023 who will be eligible for a vaccination at any point in the campaign.

The spring booster campaign is expected to start around 17th April 2023, with care home patients being vaccinated as early as possible.

Spring boosters in Sowe Valley PCN will be delivered by practice and PCN staff including paramedics, nurses, HCAs, pharmacists and Nurse Associates.

The vaccination centre at the Cricket Club on Binley Road will be open for vaccination appointments and walkins. Information will be communicated to patients as the details are confirmed.
